- **A FEW SEATS ARE AVAILABLE FOR ADMISSION IN TO CLASS XI (Science, Commerce & Humanities)**
- Application form is available in the school web-site from **30.05.2024** to **04.06.2024**. Downloaded form should be printed in both sides of an A4 size paper.
- Mere issuance of **Admission Form** or **Registration** will not confer right to admission.
- Seats will be offered to outside candidates **purely on merit basis** (Board Marks main five subjects i.e English (Lang.-I), Lang.-II, Mathematics, Science & Social Science), against the vacant seats only.
- The application form may be rejected for any kind of wrong information given there in.
- The complete filled in form along with a self attested copy of mark sheet (Digi-Locker downloaded mark sheet also be considered) should be deposited in the school office with the registration fee **Rs. 100/-** on all working days (9.00 am to 5.00 pm) latest by **2.00 pm** of **05<sup>th</sup> June 2024**.
- The selection list for outside candidates will be put on the school notice board/web-site on **5<sup>th</sup> June 2024** with all details of admission dates.
- Aadhar Card of the student is mandatory for the admission.
- **Countersigned SLC (by the DEO) and Migration certificate both are mandatory for admission if the applicant is from other than CBSE Board.**
- **Selected applicants from CBSE Board must ensure of uploading of the TC on the respective school website.**
- Candidates not fulfilling the eligibility criteria as given below (stream wise), need not apply.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

<b>SCIENCE</b>
1. Minimum <b>90%</b> in aggregate
2. Science & Mathematics together must be <b>170 marks</b> (Preference will be given to marks obtained in Science and Mathematics)
<b>COMMERCE</b>
1. Minimum <b>80%</b> in aggregate
2. Minimum <b>80%</b> in Mathematics, if Mathematics is opted as one of the subjects.
<b>ARTS (HUMANITIES)</b>
1. Minimum <b>75%</b> in aggregate
